FIRST CIRCULAR

The topic of the 3rd International Symposium on Fusarium Head Blight was discussed in Wageningen in 2006 September. The majority of the IOC members were there. We decided the date it will start with arrival and registration on Monday, 1st September, and the scientific program will last from Tuesday until Friday afternoon, 5th September. We set the session Taxonomy as the sixth Session so in the case of interest colleagues from the Italian meeting can join the Symposium. It was decided also that the US and Canadian Fusarium Forums will be organized as usual as they have not only scientific, but a wide business management character with a number of topics that should be discussed.

Excursions will be organized on Friday afternoon and Saturday, for accompanying persons during the week two additional events will be organized for extra charge.

SESSIONS OF THE SYMPOSIUM

follow the tradition from the FHB Forums and European Fusarium Seminars:

- 1. Host Plant Resistance and Variety Development including all aspects of breeding
- 2. Genetics and Genomics in Fusarium resistance
- 3. Food Safety, Toxicology
- 4. Pathogenesis
- 5. Epidemiology, disease forecasting, agronomy relations,
- 6. Taxonomy, Population Genetics and Genomics of Fusarium spp. and
- 7. Chemical, Cultural and Biological Control

In each Session two-three invited speakers will give talks that represent all important Fusarium research topics. The speakers will have 20 minutes with 5 minutes discussion. Regular oral presentations will have 15 minutes speaking time with 5 minutes discussion. Chairmen/chairladies will be asked with the approval of IOC. Invited speakers do not have an advantage in reimbursement of costs. The list of the invited speakers will be completed by the end of January.

The plants covered will be wheat, barley and other small grain cereals like triticale. We also included corn as it is one of the major feed sources, bur surprisingly few publications deal with this topic, so we would encourage research work in this very important crop in Europe. Of course, the *Fusarium* pathogens like *F. verticillioides* will also be covered.

The Proceedings will be published in Cereal Research Communications (IF: 1.037), like in 1997 at the 5th European Fusarium Seminar. Invited speakers will have seven, oral presentations five pages articles, posters will have two pages as short communications.

The structures of the sessions, and the number of regular oral presentations per session will be decided by the IOC members for the given sessions. For this a 15 line long abstract will be requested (Times New Roman, 12 pt size), deadline: 31 May 2008.

For invited speakers and poster authors the deadline for submission of the manuscripts will be **30 June 2008**. All posters will be accepted without limitations. For posters, only the short paper of two pages will be requested without preliminary abstracts until the same deadline (30 June, 2008).

Instructions to Authors

Cereal Research Communications publishes original papers, short communications, review articles and book reviews in the field of breeding, genetics, agronomy, physiology, pathology and quality of primarily wheat, maize, barley, oat, rye, triticale, rice and other cereals.

Submission of manuscripts. A style file will be put on the internet to keep the papers in a uniform manner and enhance publication process. You will see here all formal requirements.

Manuscripts must be written in standard grammatical English on A4 sheet, using margins 3.5 cm top and bottom and 2.5 cm left and right. Text should be typed continuously. We need camera ready manuscripts with figures and tables positioned on their final place. Colored figures will not be printed. Manuscripts should not exceed the given 7,5 and 2 **pages** including figures, tables and references. The articles should be assembled in the following order: **Title, Author(s), Affiliation(s), Summary, Key words, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, References.** In the two page papers Results and Discussion can be unified.

References should be given in alphabetical order according to the following examples:

Registration fee is **350 Euro** for the congress. Student fee will be **200 Euro** for PhD students. Late registration after 30 June will be 400 and 250 Euro, respectively. This includes the Welcome Party on 1st September, the Congress Party on 4th September, lunches from Tuesday to Friday, the congress concert and the hard copies of the Proceedings. Breakfast is included in the room price.
